- 1. To be treated with dignity and respect.
- 2. To notification and information.
- To be present.
- 4. To be heard.
- 5. To reasonable protection.
- 6. To restitution.
- 7. To information and referral.
- 8. To apply for victim compensation (in violent crime cases).
- 9. To speedy proceedings.
- 10. To special rights and protections.
