



MEET THE CHESAPEAKE SHERIFF'S OFFICE'S 11-TIME VICTORIOUS PLANE PULL TEAM

The Chesapeake Sheriff's Office has dominated the Dulles Day Plane Pull since 2006; taking home 11-consecutive first-place trophies. Each year the 25-man team faces off against nearly 100 other teams to see which team can pull a 186,000-pound FedEx Airbus 12-feet in the fastest time. In 2017, the CSO's Plane Pull Team wowed the crowd by pulling the massive air bus down the runway in 5.1 seconds.

The Dulles Day Plane Pull is about more than just a rivalry between the teams; **it's a labor of love**.
